

Child Safety Program

If your child went missing what would you do?

Are you prepared to take the actions necessary to recover your missing child to safety?

The United States Department of Justice sets out these 10 guidelines for parents of missing children.

<i>Department Of Justice Guidelines</i>	<i>The Pak Mail Response</i>
Immediately report the emergency to law enforcement	Sends Posters by Fax and Email to requested agencies
Request a "Be on the Look Out" Bulletin and the help of the FBI	Posters are faxed to FBI offices
Ask About Amber Alert	Posters can be sent to media agencies for Amber Alert broadcasts.
Ask for Name and Number of Responsible Officer	Pak Mail verifies this information and displays it on the posters.
Write a detailed description of your child	Pak Mail collects this information before the emergency saving valuable time
Find Recent Photos and make copies	
Ask Law Enforcement to Organize a Search	Pak Mail posters immediately available to aid in searches.
Ask Law Enforcement for help contacting the media	Pak Mail posters provide all of the information needed by the media to assist in the search.
Notify Transportation Hubs	
Distribute Posters to all possible community groups, churches, VFW, etc.
